

UTSI Wireless Network

Here is some information on how to connect to the UTSI wireless network. For the sake of uniformity, we have the same three wireless choices as found on the UTK campus

- ut-open
- ut-wpa2
- eduroam

ut-wpa2 network – a secured wireless environment.

REMEMBER TO USE YOUR NETID/PASSWORD AND THE DOMAIN IS UTK. Do not use your UTSI Username and Password.

Remember, all UT Employees and Students need to use the secure ut-wpa2 to connect to UTSI system resources such as the UTSI domain, the mail server, file shares, and the full network bandwidth.

ut-open network – unsecured environment

This connection is provided for our guests. There is no username and password. However it is subject to restrictions and reduced bandwidth

eduroam network – secured network

eduroam (education roaming) is the secure, world-wide roaming access service developed for the international research and education community. eduroam allows students, researchers and staff from participating institutions to obtain Internet connectivity across campus and when visiting other participating institutions by simply opening their laptop.

Most American visitors probably won't know much about eduroam but many international guest researchers and students will probably find it useful.
